It cost very expensive, approximately fifty millions rupiah or more, because my sores were in serious condition and the hospital did not serve with BPJS Insurance program.

On Monday evening, October 20, 2014, I was moved to another hospital that served with BPJS Insurance program. There were so many patients queuing for the surgery; even it was difficult to get a room. Nevertheless, I gave thanks to God. He used a member of our church, namely Mrs. Yunce Dongalemba as the chief of a division in that hospital to help me in booking the room and looking for the good doctor and nurse for me. Moreover, God helped me in arranging the membership of BPJS Insurance easily in thirty minutes only. I could use the insurance card immediately.

I can take some lessons from my experience. First, disobedience costs so expensive. Second, the name of Jesus is powerful to move the joints of my feet until they are normal. I thank God. I also thank Rev. Widjaja and his wife, the congregation, and youth for visiting, praying for, and helping physically and spiritually. I thank for the full-time servants of God especially Miss Johna as the computer operator for copying DVD of the recording of all services in the church when I had to be healed in the hospital.
